Wear pony club uniform when representing the Club at functions outside of the club	The rider must wear full official uniform for their club, and must be clean and tidy. Riding helmet is not required unless acting in a mounted capacity.			If providing service at any official function or outside of the club, such as street stalls, etc, the member must wear club uniform. Riding helmet is not required for such activities.
Wear pony club uniform when assisting at club rallies and functions	Summer or "casual" club uniform is acceptable when providing service in an un-mounted capacity			
Be suitably attired when providing service at club working bees	Depending on the activity or task being undertaken, work clothes or coveralls may be appropriate. Eg. Painting.
