TEAMS ON FLAT. “PCASA Test 3” This is a drill competition for a team of four riders. Each Club may enter one or more teams of four qualified riders. A non-riding team captain must be nominated with entry.

Entry Fee: \$40.00 per team

TEAMS ON FLAT “B”. This is a drill competition for a team of four riders using the “PCASA Test 3” but there will be **no turnout test**. The competition is to encourage riders to prepare themselves for the Teams on the Flat competition in future years. Each Club may enter one or more teams of four qualified riders.

Entry Fee: \$40.00 per team.

S.A.D.A. CUP. One of the events held during the State Championships is the South Australian Dressage Association 'S.A.D.A. Cup'. Each Zone is invited to send its best dressage riders to compete in a team's competition. **Riding at the zone finals is a preference for selection.** Test is EA 3.3 Dressage whips may be used if rider holds a “C” certificate.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per rider.

NOVICE S.A.D.A. An encourage dressage competition leading up to the S.A.D.A Cup. Test EA Novice 2.3. Dressage whips may be used if rider holds a “C” certificate.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per rider.

PRELIMINARY S.A.D.A An encourage dressage competition leading up to the Novice S.A.D.A. Test EA Preliminary 1.3. Dressage whips may be used if rider holds a “C” certificate.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per rider.

SHOWJUMPING (Pharaoh Cup Selection). Each Club may enter one or more teams of four qualified riders. A non-riding team captain to be nominated with entry. Maximum height of first round will be 1.15m.

Entry Fee: \$40.00 per team.

“A” GRADE SHOWJUMPING. To be run as an individual Championship competition (If equality of points after 2 rounds, third round timed over a shortened and raised course). Maximum height of first round will be 1.15 m.

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per rider.

“B” GRADE SHOWJUMPING To be run as an individual Championship competition (If equality of points after 2 rounds, third round timed over a shortened and raised course). Maximum height first round 1.00 m.

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per rider.

“C” GRADE SHOWJUMPING To be run as an individual Championship competition (If equality of points after 2 rounds, third round timed over a shortened and raised course). Maximum height first round 0.85 m.

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per rider.

MOUNTED GAMES. For A and B Division Teams. Each club may enter one or more teams, each of four or five qualified riders. Only four riders compete in each novelty. A non-riding team captain must be nominated with each entry.

Mounted games selected for 2017 are: Group 5 & 6

“A” division ride both Groups 5 and 6 - “B” division ride Group 5 only.

Mounted Games are not necessarily run in this order. Two stewards from each competing club to be conversant with the rules are required. Submit names with entry. Stewards MAY NOT be a team captain.

Entry Fee: \$40.00 per team.

**PONY CLUB HORSE AND RIDER OF THE YEAR.
(Qualifying competition for State Championships)**

The Pony Club Horse and Rider of the Year must be a combination versatile enough to compete successfully at Dressage (Test 2.3) Showjumping - two rounds, max. height 1.0 m, and Combination Novelty no. 1 (one attempt). Riders nominate themselves via their Club Secretary.

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per rider.

**JUNIOR HORSE AND RIDER OF THE YEAR.
(Qualifying competition for State Championships)**

The Junior Horse and Rider of the Year is a junior version of the Pony Club Horse and Rider of the Year. Riders may ride a different horse for this event than for any other. Dressage Test 1.3, showjumping - 2 rounds, max.height 0.80m and a combination novelty no. 1 (one attempt). If entering this event then you must not ride the same horse in a “B” grade showjumping event. **RIDERS MUST BE 16 YEARS AND UNDER ON 1st January 2017**

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per rider.

ATTENDANCE/PERFORMANCE CARDS MUST BE PRODUCED
PRIOR TO COMPETITION.

NO CARD - NO RIDE

**ALL COMBINATIONS MUST BE QUALIFIED AND FINANCIAL
FOR THE CURRENT YEAR.**

ALL RIDERS NOMINATING FOR SELECTION EVENTS MUST STATE ON THE ENTRY FORM IF THEY ARE PREPARED TO GO TO STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS (to be held in October by Southern Zone at Monarto Equestrian Centre)

Stable (\$15), or outside yard (\$10), and camping fee (\$15) if applicable, to be included with entry fee. Please indicate nights required.

NO LATE OR TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

PONY CLUB AND JUNIOR HORSE & RIDER OF THE YEAR RULES

(Refer to PCASA “Rules, Information and Policy” book for full description of Rules)

Dressage

The dressage test for both H&R competitions will be ridden during the Novice (for PC H&R) and Prelim (for Junior H&R) dressage classes. Riders must nominate if they want their dressage test to count ONLY towards their H&R score, or if they also want to be ranked in the dressage placings (they must pay an extra \$15 entry fee if they wish to also be ranked in the dressage class but will only ride the test ONCE).

Show jumping

- First Round** Riders jump a one metre maximum course against an optimum time based on speed of 350 metres per minute (Junior H&R jump a course max. 80cm, optimum time based on speed of 330 metres per minute).. Ranking of the riders will be on basis of rider of lowest faults or where there are two or more with no faults or equality of faults nearest the optimum time, whether over or under time.
- Second Round** All riders not eliminated in the first round will jump a second round. At the discretion of the course builder, this may be an altered “jump off” course. Maximum height 1m (80cm for Junior). Riders jump against the clock as in normal jump offs. Ranking of riders will be on basis of rider with lowest faults and where there are a number of riders with no faults or equal lowest faults then on shortest time taken. Overall Ranking is determined as the average of the rankings of each competitor over the two rounds.
