- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED
- ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED TO 80 COMPETITORS WITH PRIORITY GIVEN TO RIDERS IN PONY CLUB CLASSES
- NO DOGS ALLOWED ON MT GAMBIER PONY CLUB GROUNDS OR ADJOINING AIRPORT PROPERTY

EVENT INFORMATION

COMPETITORS

- A member is a Pony Club rider under the age of 17 years.
- An associate is a Pony Club rider of 17 years and under 21 years.
- A senior is a Pony Club rider of 21 years and under 26 years.
- An adult is a rider 26 years and over with a current adult card or current Pony Club card.

Age of riders determined as 1st January 2018

Qualification rules for 2018

All competitors in Pony Club competitions must be qualified **except state adult riders**. It is necessary to attend four rallies and complete a minimum of one hour's instruction at each rally. The four qualifications must be obtained in the 12 months preceding the event.

Club adult pony club members (members 26 and over of a club) may compete in any pony club class where there is a class for their age group; this includes Pony Club state championships.

State affiliated members (members of the state) can only compete in ODE's and don't need 4 rally qualifications.

All combinations who are riding in State ODE need a completion at that grade or higher in the 18 months prior. State adult riders do not need 4 rally qualifications but must have a completion at that grade or higher in the 18 months prior.

TIME TABLE & DRAW

The draw will be emailed out one week prior to the event. A full program will be available to competitors on the weekend.

SECRETARY'S OFFICE

The Secretary's office will be open from 7am Sunday 15th April 2018.

CARDS

Copies of cards and Helmet Cards are required to be sent with entries.

Please bring your Pony Club cards and Helmets with you when collecting body numbers.

Cards will be checked for grades, qualifications and financial status. **Cards MUST** be presented to the Secretary's office prior to the commencement of the competition and will be held for the duration of the competition.

NOTE: All competitors must have a current Performance Card and must be a financial member of either a Pony Club or PCASA.

Any rider who does not present a current Attendance/Performance Card will not be permitted to ride.

BODY NUMBER HOLDERS/MEDICAL ARM BANDS

Riders are required to provide their own body number holder and medical armband.

REFUNDS

Refunds after closing date will only be considered by sighting doctor or veterinary certificate within 2 weeks of the event.

CATERING

Canteen available all day.

CAMPING/YARDS – TO BE LEFT CLEAN & TIDY

Onsite camping available at \$10 per family for the weekend.

Limited Number of Yards available at \$15 for the weekend; allocated on a first in basis.

No portable yards allowed.
