Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCASA rules apply and your acceptance of these rules.

This is an OPEN competition – Pony Club, all other riders will be required to pay a day participant membership to Balaklava Pony Club Inc. A waiver form is attached.

Neither Balaklava Pony Club Inc nor PCASA Inc accepts any liability for any accident, damage or injury or illness to horse, rider, grounds, spectator or any other person or property.

Plaiting and Jackets are OPTIONAL IN ALL RINGS; you may compete in Pony Club uniform in all rings. Competitors WILL NOT be penalised.

Age of riders will be as at 01 January 2019.

Please make sure you pick up manure and hay from around your floats, it is a condition of us using the grounds that it must be picked up and taken away. Thank you.

Combinations may only compete in one set of hack classes throughout the day, Riders in any class rings are able to compete in Ring 3 Pony Club Classes (must be a full financial riding member of PCASA) & Ring 4 – Mounted Games.

Pleasure class must be ridden in a Snaffle Bit, no whips or spurs.

NO stallions or colts are permitted on the grounds.

NO dogs are permitted on grounds.

NO smoking is allowed on grounds.

Convenor on the day, Judges and/or Stewards have the authority to remove from the ring any horse/pony considered to be dangerous or to be interfering with other competitors or unsound. If a Judge feels a combination is not eligible or does not fit that ring's specifications, combination will be then down-graded or up-graded to another ring.

If you know that your horse or pony kicks please place a red ribbon in its tail so that other riders are aware.

Classes will not be held for competitors who are in another ring.

All horses and ponies MUST WALK in any area that is not a practice or competition area and must obey direction from appointed grounds people. If this is not adhered to the committee have the right to ask persons to leave the grounds.

PCASA approved helmets and boots must always be worn when mounted.

ALL Pony Club Classes will be run under PCASA rules and Pony Club uniform must be worn in these classes.

For classes whose winners are eligible for Champion classes, 2nd place getters should stand by for Reserve Champion.

If weather is Hot or Wet according to our Balaklava Pony Club Weather Policy. Balaklava Pony Club committee will do our best to advise everyone via the MYAUSHORSE Website Event Notice and the Balaklava Pony Club Facebook page and Facebook Event Page. The Committee of Balaklava Pony Club will reschedule the Gymkhana

Hot Weather Balaklava Pony Club supports the SUNSMART policy.

When the forecast temperature for Balaklava SA is 35 degrees or over on the BOM weather website <http://www.bom.gov.au/places/sa/balaklava/forecast/> on the Friday evening at 7.30pm prior to the event, the event will be cancelled.

If the forecast temperature is predicted to be between 30 and under 35 degrees the start time will be ½ hour earlier. Eg: 8.30 am

Wet Weather will be decided Friday night before the event at 7.30 pm by the Executive Committee (President, Vice President, Secretary & Treasurer). This will be decided with safety of both horse/pony and riders in mind (our duty of care).

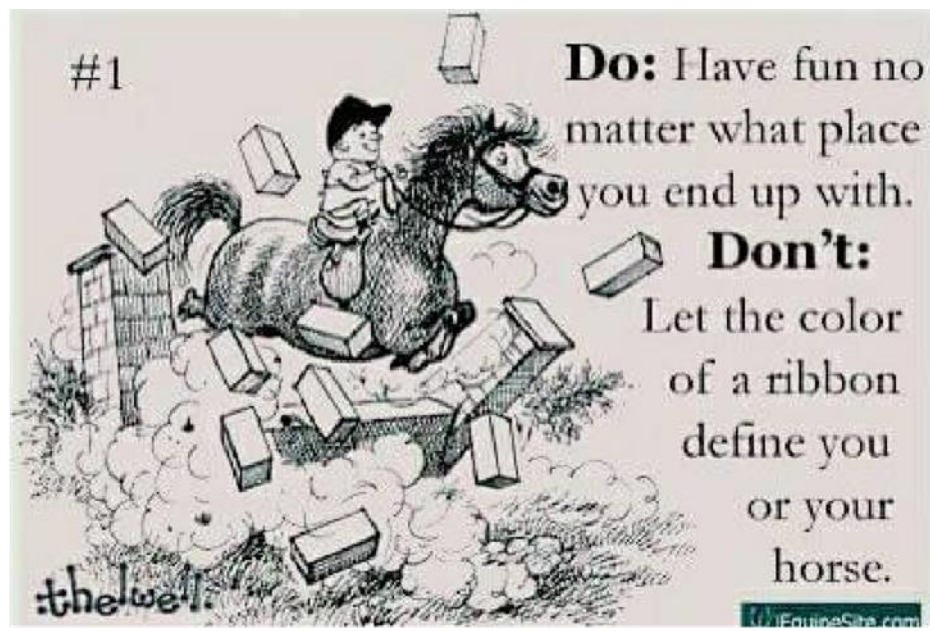

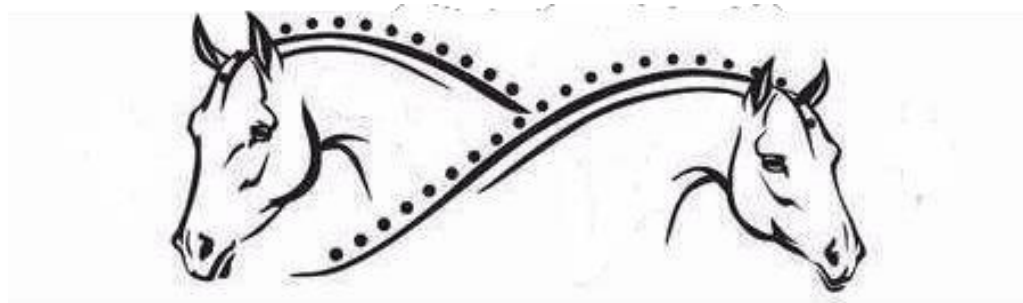

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the cancellation of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse no matter where that may occur.
