

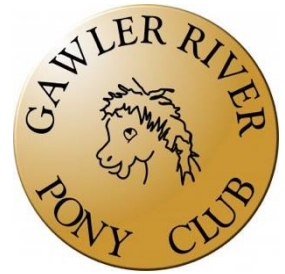

Rules and Regulations

- This event will be run under PCASA Inc rules www.ponyclub.asn.au
- Copies of dressage tests are also available on PCASA website and EvA tests can be found on <http://www.equestrian.org.au/Eventing-Dressage-test>
- NO CARD NO RIDE. All performance cards must be current and up to date. Cards must be presented when collecting body numbers. All riders must be graded and have 4 qualifications to compete. (Qualifications must be within 12mths preceding the event)
- The Committee reserves the right to combine classes of the same grade if entries are low or to ballot out entries if numbers warrant
- Riders must supply their own body number holders and medical arm band.
- All riders must wear full pony club uniform, rally shirts and rugby jumpers permitted for cross country.
- Riders eliminated excluding a fall during any phase may be able to continue at the discretion of the TD and the grounds committee. In the event of a fall, riders will be eliminated as per PCASA rules
- Refunds will only be given for withdrawals before the close of entries, unless either a veterinary or medical certificate is produced.
- Behaviour deemed inappropriate to fellow competitors, officials, visitors or horses may result in elimination.
- If a mount is deemed dangerous during the event it may result in elimination
- There are compulsory gear checks before each phase.
- All protest must be lodged in writing accompanied by \$50 within 30 minutes of results being posted of the relating phase of the protest.
- Neither the Committee of the Gawler River Pony Club Inc nor the owners of the land accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse, rider, groom, spectator, person or property.
- Cars without floats attached must be parked outside of the grounds except event organisers or with permission from organising committee.

Camping Information

Camping is available at \$10 per night

There is a designated camping area on the grounds, please report to secretary's office prior to setting up No horse is to be left unattended no exceptions

All campers are expected to be considerate of others and leave their camping area clean

Presentation etiquette

All place getters to present in official pony club uniform including helmet. Riders not presented in full uniform will not be presented with prizes.

Points will be allocated to relevant place getters.

Place getters cards will not be returned until after the presentations.

The organising committee will endeavour to hold presentations as soon as possible after the last rider has competed.

Yards

11 yards available at a cost of \$10 per day + \$20 Bond (refunded upon inspection). Please ensure you leave these yards clean and respectable.

Campers will be given priority.

Horses may be kept in temporary yards

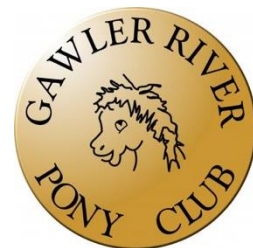
