RULES & CONDITIONS

Entry to the show grounds is governed by the following rules, regulations and conditions:

1. **The Pegasus Pony Club Inc** will not be liable or held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to horse, person, vehicles or equipment whilst on the grounds.
2. **Competitors who are not financial member of PCASA, Trail rider assoc, Arab Assoc, Endurance Assoc or the EA will need to pay a \$10 visit membership / insurance levy to compete in any ring and complete the day participation and waver forms. (Listed members will need to present their cards on the day to compete and fill out the forms only.)**
3. Protective headgear (ASA/AZ 3838, ASTM F 1163(USA) or early Europe VG1) must be not be more than 5 years old and appropriate boots must be worn while mounted.
4. Competitors riding faster than a walk through raceways and entrances will be asked to leave the grounds.
5. Stewards have the right at the discretion of the judge to remove from the rings any horse/rider/handler that does not comply with the rules, constitutes a hazard to other competitors, or behaves in an unruly manner.
6. **The Pegasus Pony Club Inc** reserves the right to alter or cancel any event on the program, or combine any event at the committee's discretion.
7. The judge's decision on the day will be final.
8. Ages of the riders where indicated are ages on the 1st January 2019.
9. All protests must be lodged within 15 minutes of completion of the event together with a \$50 protest fee. The decision of the protest coordinating committee will be final.
10. Programs are correct at the time of publication, and are subject to change without notice.
11. Stallions and colts ineligible.
12. **MAIDEN:** A horse/pony/rider who has not won a ribbon in an individual hack/rider class at any show or gymkhana.
13. **NOVICE:** A horse/pony/rider who has not won a first prize in an individual hack/rider class at any Agricultural show or gymkhana
14. All pleasure classes are to be ridden in a snaffle.
15. **L PLATE RING:** Open to all ages and to be led or just off the lead to be accompanied by a capable person over 12yo.
16. **WALK/TROT RING:** Open to all ages and horse breeds, No cantering.
17. **ENCOURAGE RING:** Open to any rider who walk, trot and canter.
18. Judges may change rider's admission to another ring at their discretion if deemed at a different level of riding suitable to that ring.
19. No Dogs permitted on to the grounds.
20. There is to be no lunging of horses on the grounds whatsoever.
21. Holes dug and any other damage to the grounds incurred by horses and visitors will be asked to rectify the damage.
22. Only vehicles with floats attached will be permitted to park on the grounds.
23. Yards reserved for horse and ponies ridden onto the grounds with no vehicles to tether to, must be cleaned after use.
24. Hot Weather Policy If temp is above 34 degrees reported by Channel 9 on 6pm news the night before, will be a morning event only, if above 37 degrees, event will be postponed.
25. Should a Tee Shirt be worn in the ring, it must be in good condition, cause no offence to any party and display non-political or non-religious content. Offending apparel will result in the rider being refused entry into the ring.

In the interest of safety and as part of our commitment to risk management the following rules will apply for leading rein classes and led riders.

1. The handler is to lead the rider from the near side of the pony/mount.
2. The handler is to remain as close as possible to the girth, level with the rider and ready to assist the rider if needed.
3. The handler will hold the lead in the left hand, leaving the right hand free to be of most value, a safety net to the rider.
4. Leads must be attached to the noseband or halter –**NOT** to the bit.
5. Snaffle bridles with cavesson nosebands only.
6. No chains allowed.
7. Handlers must wear suitable footwear.
8. 'Monkey' or neck straps are encouraged.
9. Horses not in control of a competent handler will be asked to leave the ring and remove the rider from the pony/mount.

I, the undersigned, in consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious injury or death may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event and freely assume all such risks, even if arising from the negligence of PCA SA and/or the event organiser / official.

I voluntarily participate at my own risk and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the cancellation of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse no matter where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this show and the official Rule Book of the Pony Club Association of South Australia.
