

Penola Pony Club's Inaugural Arena Show Cross Training Day

Sunday, March 17th 2019

General Information and Entry Form



The Arena Show Cross Training rounds will be held entirely on the main arena at Penola Pony Club. For those who are unfamiliar with the grounds this area is approximately 3 times larger than a normal show jumping arena.

This Training Day is an excellent opportunity for riders to 'have a run' and do some schooling before the autumn eventing season starts in our local area. It is also an ideal opportunity for younger or inexperienced riders to complete a longer course in a controlled environment.

To enable training over a range of obstacles, a combination of show jumps, working hunter type fences and cross country style jumps will make up the courses. There will be up to 20 jumping efforts per course.

Riders may be assisted and/or supported and encouraged whilst completing their rounds but must be able to ride independently. Instructors will be available to give assistance if required.

There will be an optimum time for each height. See table below.

Combinations may enter **2** classes for the day. This may be 2 different height classes or the same height twice. E.G. A combination can do Class 2. 40- 50cms **and** Class 3 50-60 cms **OR** Class 2 40-50cms twice **OR** Class 3 50-60cms twice etc.

General Pony Club Rules will apply. Current PCASA rules can be found at www.ponyclub.asn.au

As this is a training day, PC members must be financial and have an attendance/performance card, displaying their jumping grade, but need not be qualified.

EA Riders must fill out a waiver form prior to riding and pay the \$15 fee as required by PCASA. EA riders may choose the heights they wish to jump based on their level of experience and competence.

Training Classes

	Height	Speed * slower than eventing speeds
Class 1.	30- 40cms	275 metres per minute
Class 2.	40- 50cms	280 metres per minute
Class 3.	50- 60cms	300 metres per minute
Class 4.	60-70cms	350 metres per minute
Class 5.	70-80cms.	350 metres per minute

To add to the fun, one of your classes will be your 'music round'. Choose your theme song and it will be played whilst you are in the arena.
