A: 12 years & under	6th place
B: 13 years & under 17	4th place
C: 17 years & under 26 (Associate)	4th place
D: 26 years and over (Adult)	4th place

Conditions:

- Riders can ride in **no more than two consecutive levels** of test (ie. grades 4 & 5 or grades 4 & Prelim).
- Maximum of two horses per rider.
- Maximum of one rider per horse.
- Maximum of 3 tests per horse and rider combination.
- Combination of horse and rider may compete at grade on dressage card and one grade higher.
- **Entries close by last mail Wednesday 19th May.**

No late entries will be accepted.

No phone or Facebook entries will be accepted.

Please do not attend if you or your family are ill.



Observation of 1.5m personal space, hand washing with soap and water and use practicing social distancing to be followed according to current COVID-19 regulations. All persons on the grounds are required to QR register.

Rules and Regulations

Entry to the show grounds is governed by the following rules, regulations and conditions:

1. Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person.
2. This competition will be held under the rules and regulations of the PCASA (<http://www.ponyclub.asn.au/>)
 - All tests must be ridden in a snaffle. The bouche (hanging snaffle) and Wilkie bits are dressage approved.
 - Equipment not approved for dressage includes martingales, protective boots on horses' legs and spurs in Preparatory tests.
 - Dressage whips may only be carried by riders with C certificates or riders over 26yo.
3. This dressage competition is open to all riders who are financial members of a pony club affiliated with the Metropolitan Zone Pony Club Association of the PCASA.
4. Protective headgear (ANZS3838 and other listed codes) and appropriate boots must be worn while mounted.
5. Competitors riding faster than a walk anywhere other than designated warm-up or competition areas will be asked to leave the grounds.
6. Stewards have the right at the discretion of the judge to remove from the rings any horse/rider/handler that does not comply with the rules, constitutes a hazard to other competitors, or behaves in an unruly manner.
7. The Pegasus Pony Club Inc reserves the right to alter or cancel any event on the program, or combine any event at the committee's discretion.
8. The judge's decision on the day will be final.
9. Ages of the riders where indicated are ages on the first of January 2021.
10. Official Pony Club uniform must be worn.
11. Riders can ride in no more than two consecutive levels of test
12. Programs are correct at the time of publication, and are subject to change without notice
13. No Dogs to be brought on to the grounds.
14. There is to be no lunging of horses on the grounds whatsoever.
15. Any yards used must be left clean and chains secured. Any holes dug by horses must be filled before leaving the event.
16. Only vehicles with floats attached will be permitted to park on the grounds.
17. Refunds of entry fees will only be given if vet or doctors certificate is shown to the committee within 2 weeks of the event. Refunds will be given before close of entries.
18. This Metropolitan Zone Dressage Day incorporates the Doris Crowley Perpetual Dressage Day Trophy.
- 18. Failure to produce The Dressage Pony Club Card (blue card) will mean you are unable to compete in any of the events on the day and are unable to ride on the grounds.**
