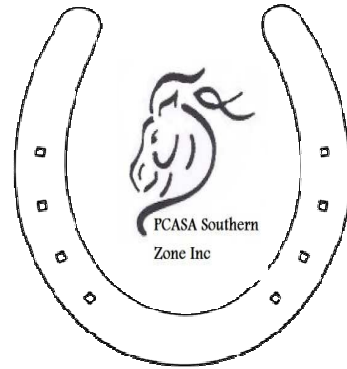

~ Round 3 of the PCASA Southern Zone Dressage High Points Series ~

### Classes:

- 1) Preparatory: Walk-Trot Junior (under 12 years)**
- 2) Preparatory: Walk-Trot Senior (over 12 years)**
- 3) EA Preliminary Test 1.2 Junior**
- 4) EA Preliminary Test 1.2 Senior**
- 5) EA Novice Test 2.2**
- 6) EA Elementary Test 3.2**
- 7) EA Medium Test 4.2**

Combinations may compete at the level on their dressage card and/or one grade above.

No more than 3 tests per horse over no more than 2 consecutive levels (eg. graded Prelim, can ride the Prelim and both Novice tests; or graded Novice, can ride both Novice and an Elementary test; but not a Prelim, Novice and Elementary).

Age of rider is as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018.

## **Dress**

Official Pony Club uniform; Club shirt and tie, jumper (unless summer dress declared on the day), cream or beige or club approved jodhpurs. Approved helmet and boots must be worn (new helmet rule applies). If gaiters/chapettes/leggings are worn they should be the same colour as the riding boot.

## **Approved gear for Pony Club Dressage (refer section 6 of PCASA General Rules).**

All tests must be ridden in a snaffle. The Boucher (hanging snaffle) and Wilkie bits are approved for dressage. Martingales are not permitted. Protective boots on the horse's legs are not permitted. Spurs are not permitted in Preparatory tests. A whip may be carried but is not to exceed 75cm in length. Dressage whips may only be carried by riders with their "C" certificate.

Gloves are optional. Plaiting of horses is optional. Body or saddlecloth/bridle numbers not required, please present to the judge before your test and give your name and your horse's name.

Calling of tests is discouraged but may be allowed where special circumstances exist. Please advise when presenting to the judge before your test if you need to have the test called.

**A gear check will be compulsory for all competitors. Please present to the gear checker at least 15 mins. before your test.**

## **2018 Southern Zone Dressage High Points Series**

Awards will be presented at the last fixture of the Series to the combination with the highest points in each of the dressage levels (prep, prelim, novice and elementary). 1 point will be awarded for riding in the test, and 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> placings will earn additional points.

Riders should nominate at the beginning of the series which horse they want to earn points for (if riding more than one horse only one can be eligible for a High Point award). The same horse may be ridden at 2 consecutive levels (e.g. if a combination is graded Prelim on their card, they can compete in both the Prelim and Novice tests) but a combination can only win a High Point award at one level. Combinations must be qualified for points to count.
