Class 1	Encourage Grade 5 Pony Club (Pony Club Test 5A) Under 17 years (max 35cm)
Class 2	Grade 5 Pony Club (Pony Club Test 5A) Under 17 Years
Class 3	Encourage Adult Grade 5 (EA Test Preliminary 1.1) 17 Years and over (max 35cm)
Class 4	Grade 5 Adult (EA Test Preliminary 1.1) 17 years and over
Class 5	Grade 4 Pony Club (Pony Club Test 4A) Under 26 years
Class 6	Grade 4 Adult (EVA 80-95 Test 1 -2016)

Competitors can enter the ODE, Dressage only, or the 2 phase competition of Dressage and Show Jumping Combined. They can also enter all 3 competitions if they wish.

There will be one draw for all Dressage Tests – and Competitors entering the Dressage Only, or 2 Phase or the ODE will only sit the Dressage test, and jump their Show Jumping round once. There will be no separate Show jumping or Dressage Tests. Competitors can compete in just the 2 Phase or Dressage Only Competition if they wish.

Ribbons (to 3rd Place) will be awarded at the end of the day for the 2 Phase, and Dressage only.

The encourage Grade 5 (Class 1 & 3) are only for combinations who have not placed more than 3 times in any grade 5 event, and no points will be awarded.

It is the responsibility of every competitor to be aware of these rules.**

GENERAL RULES

- **No PCASA Card—no ride! This rule will be enforced – Only Financial Pony Club SA Members can compete.**
- All performance cards must be current & up to date. Cards must be presented when collecting body numbers.
- All performance cards will be retained until after presentations, no exceptions. Riders wishing to have cards posted back must supply a stamped self-addressed envelope or card will be held until one supplied.
- All riders under 26 years must have 4 qualifications in card to compete (this includes riding HC). Qualifications must be dated within the last 12 months of the date of this event.
- Riders must supply their own body number holder, including a medical pouch or armband. A4 body number holders must be worn for XC phase of the competition, rider's hair must not obscure number. Bridle number holders may be used for Dressage & Show jumping phases.
- Pony Club riders must wear full pony club uniform for dressage, show jumping and presentations. Club T shirts may be worn for cross country. Dress for adult riders: as per Pony Club or EFA rules. Medical identification must be worn.
- Riders, who do not present to an arena or start having been twice called to start their competition, will be given a 5 minute warning. If at the end of that time, they do not attend, they will be eliminated unless they have spoken to the Marshall
- Pony Club approved helmets and smooth soled riding boots must be worn. All helmets must be less than 5 years as per PCASA Ruling.
- **All riders must supply a jump judge steward, no exceptions will be given. Those riders who do not have a jump judge steward will be required to do jump judge stewarding in another grade themselves, no exceptions**
- **Those riders only doing the combined training must supply a helper to participate in the event, no exceptions**
- Riders eliminated on the cross country will not be able to continue as per PCASA rules.
- Elimination on the cross country course, means riders **must leave the course unmounted at a walk, reporting to the finish line & not interfere with oncoming riders.**
- **All riders who have had a fall in any phase, while on ground or during warm up must report to the first aid officer.**
- Refunds will only be given for withdrawals before the close of entries, unless either a veterinary or medical certificate is produced.
- Any rider is only able to ride a total number of 2 horse throughout the event. A third horse may be ridden HC at the discretion of the organisers.
- Behaviour or cruelty deemed inappropriate to fellow competitors, officials, other visitors or horses may result in elimination
- If a mount is deemed dangerous during any phase of the event may result in elimination
- There are compulsory gear checks before each phase in all classes, riders who ride without compulsory gear check will be eliminated.
- The organising committee reserve the right to ballot out entries if numbers warrant; dividing classes if necessary and refusing entries with or without stating reasons.
- The cross country course will be open once it has been inspected and passed – Riders will be notified.
- All protests must be lodged in writing accompanied by \$50 within 30 minutes of results being posted.
- No smoking in the vicinity of the clubrooms/Canteen or Secretaries Office.
- **All competitors and visitors to the NYPPC grounds are expected to leave the grounds in a clean and tidy manner**

Camping: Camping fee of \$10 per horse

- No horse is to be left unattended - no exceptions
- All campers are expected to be considerate of others and leave their camping area clean – Caravans with awnings to be set up facing away from riding area, and tents to be packed up by 7.30am on day of competition.

Yards: There are 10 yards available. Each yard is \$20 and includes a \$10 (refundable) bond to cover costs the club may incur if yards are damaged or not cleaned.

- **Horses may be kept in temporary yards (behind floats) or tied to floats (attached to vehicles at all times)**

PRESENTATION ETIQUETTE: Presentations are a component of our event.

All place getters to present in FULL official riding uniform. **NO jeans, track pants or shorts, thongs or runners**

Points will still be allocated to relevant place getters.

Place getters cards will not be returned until after presentations.

The organising committee will endeavor to hold presentations as soon as possible after the last rider has competed.

Any entries received and accepted after 23rd February 2018 may attract a late entry fee of \$20

Each entry must include a nominated jump judge for the day.

Your entry will be refused if you don't supply a jump judge
