A Derby is a combined Show jumping (SJ) Course that comprises both Cross Country (XC) and SJ Fences. The competition takes place over a distance between 750m and 1300m over a course which comprises at least 50% natural obstacles (ie XC jumps). It's like an ODE without the dressage phase, and where you do the SJ and XC as one course.

- Water is available on the grounds
- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCASA rules apply and acceptance of the rules. PCASA rules may be found at <http://www.ponyclub.asn.au/documents/rule-book>.
- Rules for the Derby will be run in accordance with the Show Jumping rules.
- Queries, horse abuse rules etc as per PCASA Handbook of By Laws. No protests will be accepted, however, enquiries are welcome.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class alter times, refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club Association Of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other persons.
- No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted. **Late entries may be accepted, subject to a \$10 late fee.**
- For pony club members, PCASA club member cards must be presented to the Secretary's desk before riding. NOCARD NO RIDE.
- For EA member, current 2020/2021 EA membership card must be sighted at the secretary's desk before riding. NOCARD NO RIDE.
- Approved helmets must be worn and must be no more than 5 years old. Helmets to be inspected at the Secretary's desk prior to riding. PCASA helmet tags accepted.
- Competitors may ride more than one horse.
- Gear check for PC and EA riders before riding in the competition is required.
- Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors
- Competitor numbers- the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise rider numbers. Competitors' body numbers must be used and will be available for collection at the secretary's desk.
- Watches may be used.
- Winners to present for presentations unmounted and with their horses bridled. Placegetters to be without mount, in full PC uniform for the presentation of ribbons.
- No stallions or rigs permitted on the grounds
- No dogs permitted on the grounds.
- At a competition only the competitor may ride their horse or pony. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.
- No day membership is available.
- At the time of publication –all riders and spectators MUST adhere to the current COVID-10 regulations: Frequent hand washing with soap and water and practising the current required social distancing is required. Canteen facilities will be available as per COVID guidelines. All persons must follow directions from the COVID Marshalls. **Please do not attend if you or your family is ill.**
