## RULES OF ENTRY

### **SADA/Elementary, Novice & Preliminary Team & Individual Dressage**

Elementary 3.2 Novice 2.3 Preliminary 1.3

Riders under 26; Each zone to nominate a maximum of 4 teams and or individuals with a maximum of 20 rider combinations per zone and riders 26 years & over: Each Zone may nominate a maximum of 1 team per level, if a team can not be formed then individual riders may be nominated.

Excluding Teams on the flat.

*FOR CLARIFICATION REFER PAGE 99 OF RULE BOOK*

JUNIOR, SENIOR AND ADULT HORSE & RIDER COMPETITORS WHO ARE ALSO COMPETING IN PELIMINARY, NOVICE OR ELEMENTARY TEAMS/INDIVIDUALS ARE TO BE PLACED IN FIRST POSITION IN TEAM ON ENTRY FORMS (this is to enable better control of timetable).

Competitors over 17yrs with their C Efficiency that are using EA bits will need to produce their small green card at each Gear Check Point. Not presenting this card may result in competitors not being able to compete with said bit/s.

### **Teams on the Flat**

Each Zone may enter 1 team consisting of 4 riders from 1 or more clubs chosen at the Zone finals. Test 3

### **Pony Club Horse & Rider of the Year Junior, Senior and Adult**

**Senior** – Each Zone may enter 1 qualified Pony Club combination. Test Novice 2.3 GAME 1

**Junior** – Each Zone may enter 1 qualified Pony Club rider aged 8 to 16 years Test Prelim 1.3 GAME 1

### **Composite Mounted Games**

Each Zone may enter 1 team which is made up of 5 riders under 26 years and from 2 or more clubs Games as above.

Each Zone may enter 1 team which is made up of 5 riders 26 years and over from 2 or more clubs. Games as above.

### **Show Jumping Competitions**

Each Zone is entitled to enter teams of 3 to 4 rider combinations in each grade.

Each Zone is entitled to enter teams of 3 to 4 riders combinations 26 years and over in each grade.

**A GRADE-Pharaoh Cup** riders aged 11 years and over may compete, also individuals

**A Grade Adult Show jumping**

**B GRADE – Hygain Cup** also individuals.

**B Grade Adult Show jumping** also individuals

**C GRADE -Highlander Cup** Only teams no individuals.

**C Grade Adult Showjumping** Only teams no individuals

**RIDERS CAN RIDE THE GRADE ON THEIR CARD AND OR ONE GRADE HIGHER FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS ONLY.**

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

**PERFORMANCE CARDS:** COPIES OF ALL CARDS MUST BE SENT WITH ENTRIES OR EMAILED TO SOUTHERN ZONE SECRETARY. Cards will be collected and returned to riders after the gymkhana has concluded. Riders not producing cards, or producing incomplete cards will not be allowed to ride.

**SECRETARIES PLEASE NOTE, NO PONY CLUB CARD -NO RIDE WILL APPLY AT THIS EVENT WITH NO REFUND OF MONIES PAID.**

**HELMETS:** All riders need to produce their approved helmets for gear checking at the secretary's office on arrival. **HELMET CARD REQUIRED.**

**COMPETITOR:** A competitor is defined as a horse and rider combination. Once on the grounds horses may only be ridden by their competing rider (at risk of elimination).

**UNIFORM:** Competitors must wear full Pony Club Zone/Club Uniform for all events (Mounted Games excluded) and also for presentation.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** All competitors must be qualified members of an affiliated Pony Club. (i.e four qualifications) refer general rules page 35.

**UNMOUNTED PRESENTATIONS:** All riders who have competed on Saturday & Sunday are requested to attend the unmounted presentation which will take place at approximately 5pm Saturday & 1pm Sunday ( TBA on the day).

**DRESSAGE WHIPS:** Riders competing in teams dressage, individual dressage or Horse & Rider competitions who wish to use dressage whip (dressage phase only), cards must have dressage whip sticker on their attendance/performance and be sent in with entries.

**SHOW JUMPING GRADES:** Competitions will adhere strictly to grades stipulated on Performance Cards and **OR** one grade higher. Once a combination places at Pony Club State Championship they will take points for that grade. If there are less than six competitors in a class, placing points need not be accepted. If there are six to ten competitors in a class, riders must accept placing points for 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> places only

**PROTESTS:** Written protests accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 must be handed to the Secretary within 10 minutes of the final result of an event being posted. If there is a solid reason for protests (ie. a clerical error) please see the Secretary. If the protest is upheld money will be refunded.

**AGE OF HORSES:** Horses in jumping and mounted games competitions must be a minimum of four years of age.

**SMOKING:** Smoking is not permitted on the grounds. PCASA promotes a smoke free policy.

**DRUGS: Elicit drugs (smoking or taking will not be tolerated) PCA policy**

**ALCOHOL:** Is permitted at individual camp sites. Underage drinking will not be tolerated.

**NO DOGS ALLOWED. People bringing dogs onto the property will be asked to remove them.**

**CAMPING:** Camping is welcome. Money payable with entries. Please leave all campsites clean. Unpowered \$15 per site for the weekend.

**YARDS:** Yards available. \$30 per horse for the weekend, inc. \$10 bond refundable on inspection of clean yard.

**STABLES:** Preference for stables will be given to Team on Flat horses. \$50 for the weekend, inc. \$20 bond. Portable yards permitted no rope or electric tape yards please. Small paddocks also available, \$20 per horse/night, please enquire with Event Secretary.

Yards will not be allocated; please select yards near your camping area. Stable allocation will be in Secretary's Shed.

Yards and stables to be booked with entries.

**Manure:** there will be a designated collection point

**FODDER:** Daish Irrigation and Landmark Murray Bridge

**VET & FARRIER SERVICES:** Will be on call during weekend – please enquire at Secretary's Shed.

**CATERING:** Full catering will be available on Saturday, Sunday & Monday. No evening meals provided.

**ACCOMMODATION:** Some dormitory accommodation available on site; please bring all bedding. Toilets and showers on site. Hotel accommodation available in Murray Bridge, Mount Barker and Strathalbyn.
