

# MEMO

## South Australia Covid-19 – Stage 1

### This memo supersedes the previous memo sent Monday 11/5/2020

Due to the updated information from the Government re the coronavirus PCASA are changing the band on Pony club activities.

All Pony Club **training** activities/events must be restricted to no more than **11** people per group (1 coach and 10 riders) and maintain the 1 person per 4 square metres and social distancing of at least 1.5 metres until further notice.

**UPDATED INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM GOVERNMENT TODAY 11/5/2020, PROVIDES FURTHER DETAILS ON THE RETURN TO SPORT FOR STEP 1 -**

- **PARTICIPANTS** - previous advice was that 10 participants included a coach. We now know that 1 coach AND 10 participants in a group is permitted (maintaining 1.5m distance between participants)
- **MULTIPLE GROUPS OF 10** - there may be multiple groups of up to 10 people participating in training at the same venue, provided you can clearly demonstrate that 1 person per 4 square metres is being met (e.g: three clearly marked zones on one field, 10 players per outdoor netball court)
- **TOILETS & CHANGE FACILITIES** - as we heard on Friday, toilets can be used sparingly (and cleaned regularly) but change and shower facilities are not permitted to be used
- **FOOD & BEVERAGE** – no food or beverages are to be provided at the venue (whether for purchase of otherwise) for consumption on the grounds (including in any clubrooms) of the venue.
- **CARE GIVERS** –participants cannot be accompanied by any more than 1 caregiver who is not participating (riding/leading rider). It should be noted that caregivers can remain at the venue as long as they maintain social distance at all times.
- Minimise socialising after training – get in, train, get out

- Gear checking is to be done by parent or rider if older under the guidance of the coach or gear checker. Make sure they are provided with clear instructions so that these people know what is expected of them. They would be considered volunteers in this respect so please make sure a note of who was gear checking on each occasion and keep a register. (This is so they are covered by Insurance)
- Your nominated first aid person is to use gloves and correct hygiene practices as required. Your nominated first aid personnel should not be anyone who is vulnerable and must have completed the covid-19 infection control training.
- Storage areas are not a place of congregation – 1 person per 4 square metres.
- If your grounds are 185mX155M or larger you may have 3 zones with groups of no more than **11** people. ( 1 coach and 10 riders)
- Members to bring own hand sanitizer and use it often

If you have been overseas or interstate in the last 14days, are feeling unwell or have been in contact with someone who has been overseas/interstate, unwell in the last 14 days or has been diagnose with COVID-19 DO NOT enter any Pony Club Ground.
