

New Rules –Amended Rules - Deleted Rules – Rule Wording Clarification

Passed by the PCASA Executive Council in 2019, date changes come into effect listed with each change (to be updated if necessary after each executive meeting)

January executive meeting

(pg19) *effective 1/1/2020*

Cross Country: For the Cross Country phase of One Day Events, Club approved sporting tops (i.e. Rugby shirts) or T shirts in club colours (any design) may be worn. Hat silks may be worn.

March executive meeting

(pg23) *effective immediately (March 2019)*

Rule 3.6

All competitors in Pony Club competitions must be qualified except state adult riders. To obtain a qualification the combination must obtain a minimum of 1hrs instruction per rally, the qualifications must be obtained in the 12 months preceding the event.

For One Day Events & Zone Finals combinations to have 4 qualifications.

PCA Nationals and PCASA State Events combinations to have 4 qualifications.

For all other Club or Zone events and Achievement Certificates riders need 2 qualification (both to be from home club)

Rule 4.1 – Pg 64 clarification of existing rule

Modified Gr5 to be any height / width up to max Gr5 other specifications to be same as GR5 – class to be known as “modified Gr5 (height)cm”

Rule 3.4 – clarification of existing rule

The wording for shirt will be changed to include sleeves (short or long) and collar

Page 32 Bitless bridles – clarification

Dr Cook or Side Pull bitless bridles may be used (at rallies only) with permissions of the club Chief Instructor who must submit completed application form to PCASA.

Acavallo Hood / Phiten Calming Hood allowed – (effective immediately)

Allowed bits, boomer loose ring snaffle & Acavallo Sensitive Equisoft (effective immediately)

Change to State Championships Prizes –

Rugs for 1st place individual SADA, HOY –Junior & Senior, Individual A grade.

Saddle Blankets for 1st place Team on Flat & Mounted Games,

Ribbons to 3rd. effective immediately

A completion in EvA80 may be eligible as a PCASA State Championship ODE qualifier if necessary (exemption may apply)

May executive meeting

NibbleNot anti-grazing muzzle (now known as Munch-N-Done) permitted (effective immediately)



Change TOF turnout scoring to award marks to one decimal point – as per score sheet (effective immediately)

Page 68, **Gradings** - 6.2 wording to be changed on Grade 5 ruling to not more than 5 points. (effective immediately)

July executive meeting

Watches permitted to be worn by all riders (effective 1/1/2020)

All riders are permitted to wear spurs (effective 1/1/2020)

State members to be considered in same manner as EA riders and they can compete in the same class. Must have appropriate card for the competition they are taking part in. As these riders are self-graded if a PCASA Chief Steward or PC Chief Instructor observes them and feels they are unsafe they have the authority downgrade them. (effective 1/8/2019)

STS stirrups (not including jockey stirrup) approved for use for a 12mth trial, clearance rule not applicable to STS stirrups (effective immediately)

Comfitec bridles allowed for riders 17yrs & over who hold C certificate
