

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. All riders must wear approved helmets & riding boots.
2. Ages are to be as of 1/1/2022, if this is questioned proof of age may be required
3. Pony Club Uniform is acceptable for all classes.
4. **Pony Club members** must show their Attendance/Performance (green) card as evidence of financial status. No card no ride or pay \$10 day fee.
5. **Non-Pony Club or Equestrian Australia members** need to complete a day waiver and pay a fee of \$10.00 and cannot participate in pony club specific classes.
6. Once Combinations nominate for a ring, Open or Encourage they cannot compete in another ring. A led rider must compete led all day.
7. This competition will be held under the rules & regulations of the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. (www.ponyclub.asn.au)
8. All exhibits will be subject to a gear inspection prior to entering the ring.
9. Plaiting is optional.
10. Pleasure classes are no whips or spurs.
11. Organising committee reserves the right to split or combine classes as necessary.
12. The judges' decision is final, and no discussion will be entered into.
13. No stallions or rigs are allowed to compete in any event.
14. The committee and judges reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse/rider on the day.
15. Classes are not coordinated across rings, and classes will not be held – with the possible exception of Champion classes – due to rider clashes.
16. Ribbons will be awarded to 4th place all events
17. All riders must present to the Secretary's office before riding.
18. No smoking on the grounds.
19. All persons entering the grounds do so at their own risk.
20. Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other persons.

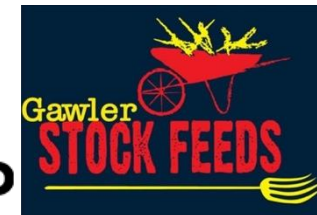

I, the undersigned, in consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious injury or death may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event and freely assume all such risks, even if arising from the negligence of PCA SA and/or the event organiser / official.

I voluntarily participate at my own risk and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the cancellation of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse no matter where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this show and the official Rule Book of the Pony Club Association of South Australia. I take sole responsibility for my actions.
