- The organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCASA accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted. **Late entries may be accepted, subject to a \$10 late fee.**
- For pony club members, PCASA club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's shed before riding **NO CARD NO RIDE**.
- For EA member, current 2020/21 EA membership card must be inspected at the secretary's shed before riding **NO CARD NO RIDE**.
- EA Riders 95cm & above must produce their jumping license
- Approved Helmets must be worn and must be no more than 5 years old. Helmets to be inspected at secretary's shed prior to riding & must have a PCASA Helmet tag.
- Competitors may ride more than one horse.
- Gear check for PC and EA riders before riding in each phase of the competition is required.
- Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors.
- Queries, horse abuse rules etc as per PCASA Handbook of By Laws. No protests will be accepted, however enquiries are welcome.
- Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise rider numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers for showjumping, however, body numbers must be used for cross-country. Body numbers will be available for collection at the secretary's shed.
- Watches may be worn in XC phase only.
- Winners to present for presentations unmounted and with their horse bridled. Placegetters to be without mount, in **full PC uniform or Open rider in show jump attire**, for presentation of rosettes.
- No stallions or rigs permitted on the grounds.
- Dogs are prohibited without exception.
- At a competition only the competitor may ride or lunge his horse or pony. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.
- No day membership available.
- At the time of publication – all riders and spectators **MUST** adhere to the current Covid-19 regulations,
