GENERAL INFORMATION

All classes will be run under PCASA rules.
Rules are available on the PCASA website: www.ponyclub.asn.au

- Pony club classes are open to members of PCASA affiliated pony clubs. PC combinations must have a graded card with 4 qualifications to be able to compete (see PCASA rules).
- Riders are able to compete at the grade they are graded at or one grade above.
- An additional \$5 PCASA Levy per combination applies & \$15 EA Levy as applicable.
- ODE competitors are asked to nominate a helper to assist with cross country jump judging. All jump judges are expected to attend a briefing at approx. 9 am Sunday morning.
- · PC riders must present a current PCASA card.
- PCASA rules for conduct of One Day Events will apply to all classes.
- Approved helmets not more than 5 years old. (with PCASA tag accepted only if you need your helmet tagged please see the gear checker first thing on Saturday), gear and riding boots must be worn by all riders. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the helmet is tagged in accordance with purchase date.
- A medical armband and A4 size body number holder must be worn for cross country. Riders are to provide their own.
- Gear check compulsory for ALL riders prior to commencing each phase of the competition. PCA Gear Rules apply https://ponyclubaustralia.com.au/sports/national-gear-rules/.
- COVID safe rules and restrictions will be strictly adhered to. Please do not attend if you are feeling unwell
 or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive to or suspected of having COVID-19, in the
 last 14 days prior to the event.
- No EFTPOS/SQUARE facilities are available at XC course (due to limited internet).
- The Committee of the Kangaroo Island Pony Club reserves the right to accept or reject or reclassify any entries without entering into any correspondence.
- Open classes are for current EA or PCASA State Members only EA membership number must be provided.
- · EA members must complete Day Participation Waiver and pay any applicable fees.
- Pony Club formal uniform must be worn for all grades (no hacking jackets except Open Classes) in dressage and show jumping. Club polo may be worn for XC.
- In the event of a rider fall; riders will be eliminated. All rider falls must be assessed by the event medical
 personnel. Riders eliminated excluding a fall during any phase may be able to continue at the discretion of
 the PC Technical Delegate and the KIPC Committee.
- PC Members over 17yrs, who do not have enough attendance qualifications may ride HC (not competitively) for experience – same fees apply. Riders 17yrs & under may not ride HC unless they have four attendance qualifications with that combination.

DRESSAGE TESTS - Pony club dressage tests are available on www.ponyclub.asn.au.

CROSS COUNTRY - The cross-country course will be open for inspection on the Saturday - Time TBC. Maps of the course will be available from the Secretary's office on Saturday (at time of check-in). Check the course maps on display at the Secretary's office for any late course alterations.

COMBINED TRAINING - up to 2 grades per combination (i.e. as graded + 1 grade higher)

ODE - one grade only per combination (either as graded or 1 grade hire)

WATER - Horse water is available, both for drinking and bucket washdown (No Hose).

DOGS - Dogs are **not allowed** on KIPC grounds or the XC Grounds (this is private property).

CATERING – BBQ/Sausage sizzle Lunch & Drinks available to purchase on both days.

CAMPING - Camping is available on the Pony Club grounds, bookings are essential and can be booked with entry form. Showers, toilets & basic kitchen facilities available.

YARDS - Day and night yards are available at \$10.00 for the weekend at Pony Club grounds. (XC course is 20 minutes from the Pony Club grounds) - horses will need to be tied to floats/trucks at XC course - no yards available.

REFUNDS - No refunds after closing date without a vet or doctor's certificate. Requests for refund must be submitted within 7 days of the event and will incur a \$20 administration fee.

PROTESTS - Protests must be in accordance with PCASA rules for the conduct of One Day Events.
