- Open to PC, PCASA Adults and EA riders.
- EA riders must sign waiver prior to riding. See Secretary at registration.
- All riders must have a current Pony Club card or proof of EA membership.
- All riders are to report to the Secretary on arrival with helmet and PC Card. Maps and body numbers will be issued for each grade. Riders are to provide their own body number holder.
- Instructors are welcome but, if mounted, must pay the appropriate entry fees & have PC or EA card.
- Limited yards are available for each session - \$10 per session to be paid on Nominate.
- Gear safety check is compulsory for ALL riders.
- ALL riders must wear Pony Club Australia approved helmet, **body protector**, riding boots, gear and a medical armband. **(A Pony Club approved body protector is now mandatory for ALL riders.)**
- Designated grades will be jumped at different session times. Please refer to the Notice Board at the Secretary's desk for any alteration to the starting times.
- Cross country jumps must only be jumped in the direction they are flagged (red flag on the right-hand side on your approach to the jump). You may only jump one grade higher than graded on your performance card or grade entered (EA riders). Please be aware and mindful of other riders.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times and are not allowed on the cross-country course.
- The organising committee reserves the right to change or alter the advertised session times, refuse or accept any entry without stating a reason, postpone in the event of extreme weather conditions.
