RULES

- All riders must be current financial riding members of a Pony Club, EA or PCASA. EA members MUST produce their jumping license as proof of grade and complete the PCASA Day Participation Waiver <https://www.ponyclub.asn.au/documents/waivers> and pay levy.
- NO CARD / MEMBERSHIP - NO RIDE.
- All persons attending must 'check-in' at the secretary's desk prior to the start of their session. Body numbers will be provided.
- Pony Club members must produce a graded card and they can only ride on the horse listed on that card and only allowed to jump their graded height and/or one grade above.
- This event is to be run under PCASA rules. Rules can be obtained from the PCASA website www.ponyclub.asn.au.
- ALL riders must have a gear and safety check before every phase of the competition. <https://ponyclubaustralia.com.au/sports/national-gear-rules/>
- Approved helmet, body protector, riding boots, gear and medical armbands must be worn by all competitors. Body protectors must be equestrian make and of standard: BETA Level 3 or EN13158:2018
- There is to be no lunging of horses on the grounds whatsoever.
- Any yards used must be left clean. Any holes dug by horses must be filled before leaving the event.
- Vehicles with floats attached must park in the designated area.
- NO smoking, vaping or DOGS allowed on the grounds.
- PCASA rules for Conduct of One Day Events will apply.
- There are limited yards available. Please see entry form to book a yard.
