<i>NON- Championship Classes</i>			

- Pony Club classes include riders of all ages (except Adult PCASA Orange Card riders: see below)
- Open Classes are for EA and Adult Pony Club Members (Orange card)
- EA Members entering Open Classes, require proof of financial status & their jumping license as proof of grade to be provided when signing in, and the waiver form to be signed & waiver fee of \$16 paid in addition to PCASA levy of \$15.
- Classes may be split depending on number of entries.
- All Classes to be run under PCASA rules.
- All riders (including EA & PCASA Adults) MUST be gear checked before competing in each phase.
- All riders must be current financial members and produce cards to the Secretaries Shed before the competition. Pony Club Rider's cards will be kept for the duration of the event and will be checked for grades and qualifications.
- Every entrant must provide a helper for at least 2 hours over the weekend; please provide name, phone number & times available.
- As per PCASA rules no HC entries in State Championship Classes – all riders MUST produce a performance card(s) clearly showing 2 qualifications in previous 12 months, completion at relevant grade, card grading & financial status.
- Open Classes, PC Gr6, Combined Competition, Supercross and Bred to Race (Thoroughbred) are not PCASA Championship classes.

FRANCIS FIGWER MEMORIAL TROPHY

The Senior Francis Figwer Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the most successful **Southern Zone** club in the Pony Club Grades 1 & 2 classes. The Francis Figwer Trophy will be awarded to the most successful club in the Junior and Senior Grade 3 only (not including Orange Card holders). Points will be awarded to place getters and the club with the most points will be awarded the trophy.

DON NICHOLS MEMORIAL TROPHY

The Don Nichols is a **Southern Zone** Club Team competition for Grades 4 & 5. Teams must be nominated to the Event Secretary by noon on Saturday 27th June. Teams can be made up of Junior and Senior riders (no adult riders) all from the same club and the same grade. They can consist of either 3 or 4 different combinations and must have at least two riders, ie. one rider riding three different horses cannot make up a team. The best three scores count.
