Riders must have 4 qualifications within a 18 month period (2 of these must be within the previous 12mths). Cards will be checked for grades and qualifications.
- As per PCASA rules **no HC** entries in State Championship Classes – all riders MUST submit copy of performance card(s) clearly showing 4 qualifications, completion at relevant grade, card grading & financial status with their entry.
- OTT (TB) are not PCASA Championship classes.
