Jupiter Creek Pony Club

- Open to Pony Club members, PCASA State Adult and EA members.
- PC classes open to Pony Club members only.
- Event is run under the rules and regulations of PCASA: <https://www.ponyclub.asn.au/documents/rule-book>
- Register and pay at the Secretary Office on arrival (no EFTPOS available).
- Pony Club Riders must bring their PC card. EA riders must show current EA membership card and sign a waiver & pay waiver fee.
- BYO water for your horses.
- No yards available.
- Approved helmets with PCASA tag, gear and riding boots must be worn by all riders.
- Gear check is compulsory for ALL riders.
- Any event updates will be posted on the Jupiter Creek Pony Club Facebook page.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program without further notice and refuse or accept any entry without stating a reason.
- Covid safe rules and restrictions will be strictly adhered to. Please do not attend if you are feeling unwell.

SZ Showjumping Series Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: I am a Pony Club member (green or yellow card), how many classes can I enter?

A: You can enter the Pony Club class you are graded in, plus one higher. You may also enter the Open class immediately below your graded class (i.e. graded D can enter Open 55cm) OR between your two grades. This makes a total of three classes per event. Only PC classes will count for the Series however.

Q: I am an EA rider, how many classes can I enter?

A: You may enter three Open classes per horse.

Q: How many horses can I enter in the Series?

A: You may only nominate one horse to accumulate points across the Series. If you are riding more than one horse in a class, you must ride the Series nominated horse first. Points are tallied for your nominated horse in either grade you enter, and whichever grade you accumulate the most points in becomes the grade you are ranked in.

Q: I am an EA rider, do I need to have a gear check?

A: Yes. As the event is run under PCASA rules, you must follow all pony club saddlery and gear rules, including a gear check. The rules can be found here: <http://www.ponyclub.asn.au/documents/rule-book>

Q: I am an EA rider, do I need to have a Pony Club approved helmet?

A: Yes. Helmets must be as per the PCA National Gear Rules. They must also have been manufactured OR purchased within the last 5 years. Without proof of purchase, the manufacturing date in the helmet will be used for dating. Clubs may offer to tag your helmet for a small fee. Your EA helmet tag does not count for Pony Club events.

Q: Do I need to have 4 rally qualifications before I can enter a Showjumping Day?

A: No. You need to be a Financial Member with a Graded card with 2 rally qualifications recorded.

Q: I am an Adult Pony Club member, what classes can I enter?

A: A Club Adult Pony Club member (yellow card) may enter classes as per Pony Club members. PCASA State Adult members (orange card) and EA members may enter the Open classes only.

Q: What is the dress code?

A: Formal pony club uniform for Pony Club classes. Formal pony club uniform or hacking jackets for Open classes. Summer dress may be called on the day by the organising committee.

Q: What is a Table A – Article 238.2.2?

A: All clear rounds to standby for jump-off at completion of the class. Placings determined by least faults in jump-off in the fastest time, Time from the first round used for any equality of placings after the second round.

Q: What is a Table A – Article 245.3?

A: All clear rounds continue straight onto jump-off after the bell is rung. Placings determined by least faults in jump-off in the fastest time.
