## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This event will be run under PCASA rules - riders must always wear PCA approved helmet and boots when riding. Please present to Secretary's desk upon arrival. All riders must be gear checked prior to warm up.

1. Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other persons.
2. A horse that is behaving dangerously and putting others at risk must be dismounted from and may be asked to leave the grounds. Stewards have the authority to remove from the ring any horse that is considered to be dangerous or to be interfering with other competitors.
3. NO STALLIONS OR COLTS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS.
4. DOUBLE BRIDLES are ONLY to be worn, for Medium & above PCA gear rules apply.
5. A gear check is compulsory for all competitors (including EA riders). Please present to the gear checker prior to warming up and at least 15 minutes before your test. If you do not have a gear check, you will be eliminated.
6. Combinations may compete at the level on their card and/or one grade above.
7. No more than 2 tests per horse over no more than 2 consecutive levels.
8. Copies of tests can be found on the PCASA & the EA websites <http://www.equestrian.org.au/dressage-rules>
9. Age of rider is as of 1st January 2028.
10. All classes will be ridden in a 20 x 80m arena.
11. Ribbons to 3rd place.
12. You MUST have a current financial PCASA card to compete in pony club classes.
13. Entry fee \$20 per class. A gate fee of \$5 per horse will apply. EA day fee will be \$20/combination
14. Entries close strictly 07/02/2028 at 9pm
15. ~ FULLY CATERED ~ Sausage Sizzle, soft drinks, water, baked items, chips & chocolate.
16. Dress Official Pony Club uniform; Club shirt and tie, jumper (unless summer dress declared on the day). EA riders must also ride in a jacket & closed shirt.
17. Full pony club uniform & jacket for EA riders must be worn for presentation
18. Approved gear for Pony Club Dressage (refer to relevant section of PCA National Gear Rules). Gloves are optional. Plaiting is optional. Please present to the judge before your test and give your name and your horse's name.
19. Calling of tests must be approved by organising committee
20. EA Riders must sign attached liability waiver; there will be a \$20 additional cost per combination. Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other persons.
21. Protests to be lodged in writing with Secretary within 10 minutes of results being posted and be accompanied with a cash deposit of \$50. The Disputes Committee decision will be final.
22. Pony club competitors need to provide PCASA performance card, showing current financial membership with 2 qualifying rallies within 12 months of the competition.
23. Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other persons.
24. Onkaparinga Pony Club committee reserves the rights to alter, cancel or delay any event.
25. Hot weather policy: If the weather is to be in excess of 35C in Mount Barker (as announced on 7pm Channel 2 News the night prior) the event will be cancelled or postponed.
