

## WHPC DRESSAGE AND SHOWJUMPING DAY

1<sup>st</sup> of March 2026

This event will be run under PCASA rules. Rules are available on the PCASA website: [www.ponyclub.asn.au](http://www.ponyclub.asn.au). It is the responsibility of every rider to be aware of these rules.

This event will run as a training day, no placings or scores will be provided.

Pony Club riders must have a performance card to ride.

Pony Club riders may only ride to the max height allowed for their graded height. These measurements can be found in the PCASA rule book.

All performance cards must be current & up to date. Cards must be presented when entering on the day of the event.

EA Riders must fill out an EA/PCASA Event participation form on the day and provide proof of financial status and pay associated fee of \$16.50 per combination.

Casual Pony Club Uniform may be worn for either Dressage or Showjumping

Riders who do not present to an arena or start having been twice called to start their competition will be given a 5-minute warning.

Dressage entries close Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> February.

Showjumping pre-entries close Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> February, entries available on the day.

**Led:** PCASA Walk Trot for the Inexperienced Rider

**Preparatory:** Preparatory 2

**Prelim:** Prelim 1.2  
\$10 per test.

**Novice:** Novice 2.2

**Elementary:** Elementary 3.2

**Medium:** Medium 4.2

*Riders may enter a maximum of two tests per horse.*

## SHOWJUMPING

Poles on the Ground	80cm
30cm	90cm
40cm	100cm
50cm	110cm
60cm	120cm
70cm	

*\$7 per round for pre-entries, \$10 per round for entries on the day.*

*Riders may enter a maximum of three rounds per horse.*
